### Camp Theme: “Experiencing Taiwan behind the Lens”

**Organizer:** Rotary Youth Exchange Multidistrict Taiwan (RYEMT)  
consisting of District 3460/ 3470/ 3490/ 3510

**Participant’s age:** 18-25 years old

**Number of Participants:** max. 12 young men or women, one from each country  
Participants will receive acceptance confirmation on the basis of first come first served.

**Camp Language:** English (it’s good if participants know some Mandarin Chinese)

#### Costs:

1. Registration fee: €200 (bank account to be announced after acceptance confirmation)
2. Round-trip airfare and travel expenses to and from the assembly venue
3. Spending money for personal expenses

**Accommodation:** host families and youth hostels

**Arrival:** July 24<sup>th</sup>, 2016 before noon, at assembly venue (Chien Tan Youth Activity Center)

**Departure:** August 06<sup>th</sup>, 2016 after noon, at assembly venue (Chien Tan Youth Activity Center)

**Insurance:** Participants must be insured against illness, accidents and third party damages according to Rotary International recommendations.

**Program:** The 4 member districts of RYEMT take turns hosting the camp participants in counter-clockwise route round Taiwan during the two-week camp time. Participants will spend three days in each district. Programs start and end at the assembly venue: Chien Tan Youth Activity Center, Taipei. There will be photography workshops, sightseeing, cultures, Rotary gatherings and friendship, as well as prizes to excellent photographic works by the participants.

7/26~28 activities in D3460 central Taiwan

7/29~31 activities in D3470 mid-south of Taiwan

8/01~03 activities in D3510 south of Taiwan

8/04~06 activities in D3490 east and north of Taiwan
