Period : Saturday, **July 1st** to Wednesday, **July 12th 2017**
(Departures at **July 13th** !)

Please note: Because of the final celebration on July 12th in the evening,
Thursday July 13th is the preferred departure day.

Participants: Max. 23 girls and boys are recommended, **aged from 15 to 19 years**
is favoured

Origin: European countries, Egypt, Israel and U.S.A. not exceeding more than **1 participants from one country**

Language: The common language in the camp is **English**

Motto: Saxony – enjoy nature, sports, sightseeing and people

Accommodation: Our guests will stay in **tents** with complete beds including sheets and blankets

Program: Nature: Walking at the Saxon Switzerland and at the surrounding landscape of the camp

- Sports:** Climbing, diving, rafting, archery, bowling, swimming
- Sightseeing:** Capitol of Saxony, Dresden, the towns of Meissen and Freiberg
- Food:** European food only, **not vegetarian, not kosher**
- Required insurance:** The participants must have sufficient health insurance , luggage insurance is recommended, accident and liability insurance is provided by the camp
- Information:** After registration the candidates will get further detailed information. If you like to get more information about our last camp, please look at our website (<https://freital.rotary.de/>)
- Visa:** Visa is obligatory for some of non-EU-countries. The participants must apply for their visa on their own.
- Costs:** The tickets to and from Dresden have to be paid by the participants themselves or by their recommending Rotary Clubs or districts.
Also an fee of **150,- €** has to be paid in advance to our bank account after receiving the AF's and confirmation of registration. You will get a demand of payment and there is 4 weeks time to pay it.

- Procedure of registration:**
1. We get information about country, sex and age of the candidate
 2. Two weeks later we have to get the AF's of the candidate (if not, registration is cancelled automatically). The candidate gets confirmation of registration or decline of registration and the reasons of it .
 3. Four weeks after confirmed registration and demand of payment the fee about 150,- € has to be paid to our bank account (if not, registration is cancelled automatically).
 4. After receiving the fee the candidate gets confirmation of participation.
