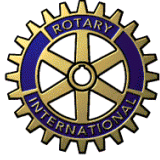

<b>Costs:</b>	Flight to and from Vienna, insurance and pocket-money for personal purposes. No additional costs
<b>Program:</b>	Vienna: Historical places like the city, castle of Schönbrunn, giant wheel etc. Surroundings: Vienna Woods, alpine mountains, Danube valley (Wachau, Melk monastery) In between there will be days for rest and shopping.
<b>Insurance:</b>	Participant is obliged to pay 40,30 € on arrival for insurance against illness and accidents, including transport home if this should be necessary – or show a certificate of his/her local insurance company in English or German, which clearly states equivalence of insurance coverage. In case of any doubt, the organizers are <u>obliged</u> to demand payment of the 40,30 € insurance fee!
<b>Arrival:</b>	At Vienna Airport: 2014-06-29
<b>Participants:</b>	Maximum number of participants: 10 Acceptation will be made strictly in order of arrival of applications! No pre-reservations accepted without full application form. The decision about acceptance or refusal of the candidate is strictly within the responsibility of the organising club(s). The organising club(s) will inform applicants about their decision as soon as possible.
<b>Age:</b>	Minimum age: 16    Maximum age: 21
<b>Application:</b>	Closing date: 6 <sup>th</sup> of June 2014  Please use your districts form or RI application form for „Short-term Program“ (PA2-763-EN-(793)994-20M/25), send copies to <u>all</u> Contact Addresses! Electronic submission of applications is highly appreciated!
<b>Special remarks:</b>	Participants should be in good physical condition. For trips to the mountains good shoes for pathways in the woods are compulsory. Swimming suits. Although July tends to be hot in Vienna, some warm cloth and a raincoat or anorak plus an umbrella should be part of the luggage – just in case...
